Overview

The 16th Asia Pacific International Conference on Information Science and Technology (APIC-IST 2021) will be held on June 20-22, 2021, in Busan, South Korea. APIC-IST has advanced since its inception, making significant contributions to the areas of CT, BT, and IT alongside parallel industrialization policy. The upcoming APIC-IST 2021 will potentially bring together emerging issues on computing environments, web applications, and their new supporting technologies to be shared by a diverse group of industry professionals and academic researchers with a common interest. All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Additionally, expanded and revised versions of a short list of the papers presented at the conference will be selected for publication in a special issue of several international journals indexed by SCIE, SCOPUS, and ISI-Web of Science.

Publishing and Award

1. Conference Paper Publishing

All accepted conference papers will be published in the conference proceedings of APIC-IST 2021. When submitting a paper (2 pages **for short papers**, or at least 3 pages **for full papers**), authors should refer to format form, which can be downloaded from the APIC-IST 2021 website.

2. Journal Publishing

Of the papers presented at the APIC-IST 2021 conference, some selected papers will be also published, after further revisions, in the following international journals. To be considered and selected for journal publication, authors should submit **a full paper (at least 3 pages in length)** regardless of whether it was originally submitted as a conference, workshop, or poster paper.

- KSII Transactions on Internet and Information Systems (indexed by SCIE)
- Journal of Internet Computing and Services (indexed by ISI-Web of Science)

3. Best Paper Award

The Best Paper Award will be distributed during the conference closing session. Authors should submit as **a full paper** to be eligible for the award.
